Regarding: Career Technical Education Pathway Certifications

The purpose of this board communication is to provide the Board information regarding Career Technical Education (CTE) Pathway Certifications earned during the 2022/23 school year. Pathway quality review and certification process ensures implementation of, and equitable access to the core principles of CTE: rigorous academics, CTE courses, work-based learning, and comprehensive student support services and is aligned to the California CTE State Plan. The certification process includes evidence collection, data review, self-assessment, and a focus on continuous improvement. Evidence and data are uploaded into an online platform and an action plan for continuous improvement is developed by the pathway team. The information is reviewed by an independent third-party organization and a recommendation for certification or improvement areas are identified.
